



We are an enthusiastic group who share an interest in visiting beautiful and interesting gardens (and if they are attached to an equally interesting building, so much the better). We meet at least once a month, varying the day to allow as many people as possible to join in at least some of the visits. Members of the group take it in turns to organise visits and we try to keep these within a reasonable driving distance i.e. a journey that would take under an hour and a half. In most instances we arrange to car share, but occasionally we have booked a coach. Lunch in the middle of a visit and tea and cakes before we leave for home is the norm.

As well as visiting various gardens throughout the year, we arrange some indoor activities in the winter months, e.g. a demonstration of Christmas decorations followed by a 'bring and share' lunch, a quiz, a slide show, Christmas Lunch, etc.

Our group was formed in April 2013. Members have a range of abilities: we are 'competent' French speakers rather than fully 'fluent'. More or less the whole of each evening is conducted in French, but there is no formal learning or teaching: only what we pick up from each other's knowledge (and mistakes!).


We normally start with a general chat about what we've been doing before moving on to more or less serious stuff. Wine (not necessarily French) is consumed - it helps to lubricate our tongues – and cheese (again not necessarily French) is often served. And we've had the occasional meal either in a restaurant or prepared by the evening's host.

Our sessions have included discussion of French news items, French film, talks around different themes that each of us has prepared (French music and singers, the history and gastronomy of Bordeaux, St Albans' twin town Nevers, French Artist Georges Braque, French Nobel laureates...), games ('Countdown', 'Tabou' 'Twenty Questions', 'Room 101'...), quizzes (French cuisine, customs, symbols, slang, texting...) and more.

- · Clubhouse changing rooms, refreshments and bar


Initially, new U3A members need only come with footwear which has smooth flat soles and comfortable clothing.

Venues

Tuesday meetings are held at Highfield (YMCA) Sports Centre, Russett Drive, off Hill End Lane, St Albans, AL4 0DB. Turn off Hill End Lane into Russett Drive at the Spar Shop. Bus S1 from and back to town every 40 minutes with a 2-hour break between 11.10 and 13.10. There is car parking at the Sports Centre.

Wednesday meetings are held at Marlborough Road Methodist Church, Marlborough Rd, St Albans AL1 3XQ. This <u>Bus</u> <u>Routes</u> web page allows you to find routes and timetables for buses that stop in St Peter's Street and Victoria Street. There is car parking at the Maltings Public Car Park, adjacent to the church.

At both venues, meetings open for registration at 2:00 pm (in the room adjoining the main hall at Highfield, in the church hall to the right-hand side of the lobby at Marlborough Road). The meetings start at 2:30pm when we sit down for announcements followed by a talk of about 45 minutes by a Guest Speaker. At Marlborough Road, tea and coffee are served in the church hall after the talk. If you could help, please contact Jean Embleton who organises the refreshments rota.






